Fact or Fiction? Clinical Pearls on Implants and Dentoalveolar Surgery

This presentation will review 'common facts' regarding implants and dentoalveolar surgery, and whether they are in fact true or false. The literature will be reviewed regarding these 'common facts', with a focus on how the literature correlates to what is seen clinically. The clinical correlation will then be highlighted. This lecture does not focus on one topic in particular, but reviews approximately 30 'common facts' and whether they are true or false. This will hopefully serve to better all attendees' understanding of common misconceptions in the dental office.

Dr. Robert Bacigalupo was raised in West Hempstead, Long Island, where he graduated from Kellenberg Memorial High School in 2005.
