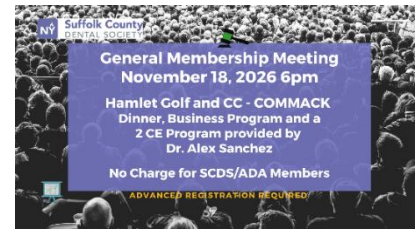

CE Program - Endodontic Microsurgery 101

Alexander Sanchez, DDS

When conventional root canal treatment is no longer sufficient to resolve persistent periapical disease, endodontic microsurgery (EMS) offers a predictable, evidence-based option for preserving the natural tooth. This lecture is designed to introduce endodontic microsurgery and its role in comprehensive patient care.



Participants will learn how contemporary microsurgical techniques differ from traditional apicoectomy procedures, review the indications and case selection criteria for EMS, and explore the clinical evidence supporting its high success rates. Through a series of clinical case presentations, attendees will gain a better understanding of when endodontic microsurgery is indicated, what the procedure entails, and how it can help patients retain their natural dentition.
