



Alright, I borrowed this from the Marines, because we could use a winning slogan to recruit additional leaders to the Suffolk County Dental Society. Alright, not just Suffolk, but NYSDA and the ADA as well. Where are the leaders who will carry the torch in 5 years' time. Who will have experience and know how? Who will be able to see through a line of crap, call it out and put forward something that is really worth pursuing? Who will hold up a mirror to ineffectiveness and enforce accountability? The profession is healthy, dental schools continue to open, more are entering the profession than are leaving the profession. This is truly wonderful. There is so much to capitalize on, yet, membership continues to be a major issue, and some might argue leadership even more so. I don't choose to have that debate at this moment. But I do feel that leadership is required to solve the membership crisis. Some might argue leadership has to recognize there is a membership crisis. Again, a separate debate, but membership and leadership issues aren't particular to organized dentistry. These exist generally in trade/business associations



outside of dentistry. Only 3 years in the past 16 years evidencing growth, all the other years a decline. By my math, this means a smaller pool from which leaders can emerge. So is it generational shifts, changing workforce preferences, technology, economic pressures, all of these and some others? Interesting in that despite the shrinking membership of the individual associations, the number of Associations has grown over that period. I see this as splintering. I think of it as specialty organizations attracting members who have elected to leave larger organizations, now both are ineffective.



Long-Term Disability Insurance Claims: What Dentists Need to Know—From an Attorney Who Knows Dentistry Personally

Dentistry is a demanding profession requiring physical stamina, fine motor control, sustained concentration, and resilience under stress. When illness or injury interferes with your ability to practice, long-term disability (LTD) insurance is supposed to be the safety net you planned for. Many dentists are shocked to learn how aggressively these claims are challenged—and how easy it is for them to unintentionally undermine their own valid claim.

I write this not only as an attorney who has successfully represented many dentists in LTD claims, but also as the spouse of a dentist whose own career was halted by chronic illness. I have seen firsthand how devastating disability can be and how confusing and adversarial the claims process becomes. Below are some of the most common ways dentists' LTD claims are challenged—and why experienced legal guidance matters.

Misunderstanding Residual Disability Coverage for Practice Owners

One of the most frequent and costly mistakes involves residual (or partial) disability claims, particularly for dentists who own practices with multiple providers.

Many dentists assume that if their clinical work declines by 50–70%, residual benefits will automatically apply. However, most policies define “earnings” as the income of the dentist *as both a provider and an owner*. This means insurers look at **overall earnings**, not just chairside production.

If associate dentists or hygienists continue generating revenue, the insurer may argue that overall earnings have not dropped by the required threshold—often 20% or more—even though the owner-dentist's personal workload has dramatically declined. Without careful analysis and presentation of financial data, a valid residual claim can be denied outright.

Overemphasis on Administrative Duties and the “Dual Occupation” Argument

Insurers routinely scrutinize how dentists describe their job duties. A common tactic is to overemphasize administrative or managerial tasks—staff oversight, scheduling, billing, or compliance—to argue that the dentist has a *dual occupation*.

In reality, for most dentists, administrative work is minimal and incidental to clinical practice. However, if this is not clearly documented, insurers may claim the dentist can still perform the “administrative occupation” and therefore is not disabled under the policy. Careful framing of occupational duties is essential to avoid this trap.

Inadequate Medical Documentation of Functional Impairment

Dentists have a tendency to work through pain and discomfort, and many physicians focus on diagnosis rather than functional limitations. A diagnosis is perhaps the smallest part of an LTD claim.

Insurers look for detailed documentation of **how symptoms impair specific dental functions**—such as sustained neck flexion, fine motor control, grip strength, endurance, or cognitive focus. Failing to develop medical records that directly tie impairments to occupational demands is one of the leading reasons claims are denied or terminated.

Attending Insurer-Requested Medical Exams Without Advocacy

Insurance company examinations—often called IMEs or “independent” medical exams—are anything but independent. Dentists frequently attend these exams alone, unaware of how statements, demonstrations, or omissions can be used against them.

Social Media, Surveillance, and Collateral Information

What you share publicly matters. Insurers routinely review social media, business websites, and other collateral sources. Posts about travel, hobbies, or practice updates—taken out of context—can and will be used to dispute disability claims.
