#### ADA Trustee Report – August 2022

It is with heartfelt thanks that I write my final report as your ADA Second District Trustee. Yes, I have made a total commitment to put all that I have into this campaign for President-Elect and remain very confident that the Trustee-Elect, Dr. Brendan Dowd will follow New York's tradition and represent you with maximum effectiveness. I wish to thank you for your unyielding support and know I will leave this position on solid ground as New York continues to be on an amazing course of leadership and direction in our profession.

Our most recent Board meeting in Chicago was held from August 12-16. I will summarize our debates and resolutions beyond what will be apparent from the Board comments you will see in your materials for the upcoming House of Delegates meeting in Houston. Many resolutions were considered on our consent calendar and removed for debate and refined by the Board. Recorded votes appear at the end of each resolution we looked at. Please understand that unanimous votes do not imply no discussion. Many times, any problems with specific resolutions are debated and agreements reached before such a vote is taken. These debates are informed and sometimes difficult, as they should be. Second District's resolution on the parliamentary "tabling motion" was recommended to vote no. I defended it but wanted you to be aware it was a demonstrative defeat. I leave the meeting with a position that agrees with the majority.

Our meeting began with reports from ADA Executive Director, Dr. Ray Cohlmia and Chief Operating Officer, Robert Quashie. They emphasized the need to move forward in a growth mode, engaging and encouraging input across all levels to develop a strong and agile, comprehensive vision for a strategically forecasted plan. Understanding that the three levels of the organization are standing shoulder to shoulder instead of a top down approach. Accurate information is the key to a smooth-running association and represents a critical step for all of us.

The ADA is positioning itself for a restructured future on a national level and we are inviting state and local societies to join in and support this vision. Internal work continues at a rapid pace on the "My ADA Life" app, focusing on meeting the needs of all target groups. This app is schedule to launch in October at SmileCon. Research and development on this app moves forward as well, striving to stay ahead of all of our "Customer Group" needs. This first version is a Minimally Viable Product (MVP) and will feature a member-to-member messaging platform. It will also include: a podcast by and for dentists; a personal document vault for saving professional documents; and a personal content feed where members select topics they are most interested in to deliver content to match their preferences and avoid too many communications with irrelevant info to the entire member base. New app features will continue to develop as member analytics demand.

Second quarter performance and activities were outlined by Robert Quashie, COO, total membership is down 3000 compared to last year, revenue was 1.9% negative to budget, while expenses showed a 7.5% favorable variance. A great deal of finance and accounting work is being done by our amazing

organizational professionals and the results are developing much needed data and accurate return on investment that has led to a great deal of consolidation and targeted accountability. Long standing programs are being carefully evaluated and those that are not performing or below expectation are being considered for reconsideration or removing all together. This is something that our future moves demand.

Our Board had an opportunity to meet with the immediate past president of the American Medical Association. Gerald Harmon, MD and Dr. Deepika Dhama, a multi-practice owner with the Pacific Dental Services, whose practice model incorporates medical inter-professional interactions through a number of avenues. These include physician/dentist shared spaces, cross referrals, and high-level patient education and diagnostic testing designed to support improvement in overall patient health. A number of forward-thinking ideas and actions were presented and discussed regarding how to best structure collaboration between both professions. This follows a meeting between Dr. Sabates representing the ADA and Dr. Harmon who shared a panel and thought that this is an excellent opportunity to join our physician colleagues in the pursuit of complete patient care and our significant role in participating in that.

The Culture of Safety in Dentistry was introduced as a topic by Tom Gallagher, MD. Director of the University of Washington Medicine Center for Scholarship in Patient Care Quality and Safety. NYSDA's very own, Dr. Richard Herman, fostered much of this discussion when he was chair of ADA Council on Advocacy for Access Prevention (CAAP) and it is progressing forward. There are many parts to this discussion, much of which was as a direct result of House Resolution 55H-2018. This laid the groundwork moving forward for a culture of safety in dentistry.

Our ADA relationships with American Student Dental Association (ASDA) and American Dental Education Association (ADEA) both emphasize growth and collaboration. Dr. Cohlmia, is a past Dean of Oklahoma University College of Dentistry, and has been visiting dental schools all across the country to establish clear goals and opportunities. The ADA hopes this will inspire input from dentists in all stages of their careers.

Finally, I would like to thank each of you for trusting me to be the conduit over the last four years between NYSDA and the ADA. I cannot express adequately what this opportunity has meant to my growth and the ability to be part of the decision-making process at the center of our organization. I will forever be grateful for the opportunity to represent each of you and feel the accomplishment of that mission is something I remain very proud of. If I have prepared my replacement to continue this great work on your behalf than the most significant part of my duty is finished. To follow those that have preceded me is both and honor and a privilege and perhaps. "Lord willing and the river don't rise" my work here is not quite done.

# **Consultation and Referral**

We all come across situations in our offices everyday when we second guess ourselves on why we started this procedure knowing it was challenging to begin with. Perhaps, the patient encouraged you to take on the case instead of referring to a special-

ist. Perhaps, a patient canceled an appointment and now you had open time in your schedule. You are confident and your were trained well. A partial third molar impaction, an upper molar endo with slight calcified canals come to mind. You think about it for a quick second and off you go. As determined as we all are, a realization sets in as you look at the xray again for the third time. There appears no end in sight. Your busy morning schedule is in jeopardy.

Know your limitations when it comes to your execution. It is so important when it comes to establishing trust and a lasting dentist -patient relationship. They can be lost very quickly with a poor decision.

Ethical guidelines are clearly defined in our Principles of Ethics and Code of Professional Conduct.

# Section 2 Principle: Nonmaleficence ("Do no harm")

The dentist has a duty to refrain from harming the patient.

This principle expresses the concept that professionals have the duty to protect the patient from harm. Under this principle, the dentist's primary obligation includes keeping knowledge and skills current, knowing one's own limitations and when to refer to a specialist or other professional, and knowing when and under what circumstances delegation of patient care to auxiliaries is appropriate.

#### **Code of Professional Conduct**

#### 2.A. Education

The privilege of dentists to be accorded professional status rests primarily in the knowledge, skill and experience with which they serve their patients and society. All dentists, therefore, have the obligation of keeping their knowledge and skills current.

#### 2.B. Consultation and Referral

Dentists shall be obligated to seek consultation, if possible, whenever the welfare of patients will be safeguarded or advanced by utilizing those who have special skills, knowledge, and experience. When patients visit or are referred to specialists or consulting dentists for consultation.

With a potentially challenging diagnosis and treatment plan take the time to explain to your patient that they will be better served with specialist . After all, The American Dental Association calls upon each member dentist to follow high ethical standards which have the benefit of the patient as their primary goal.
