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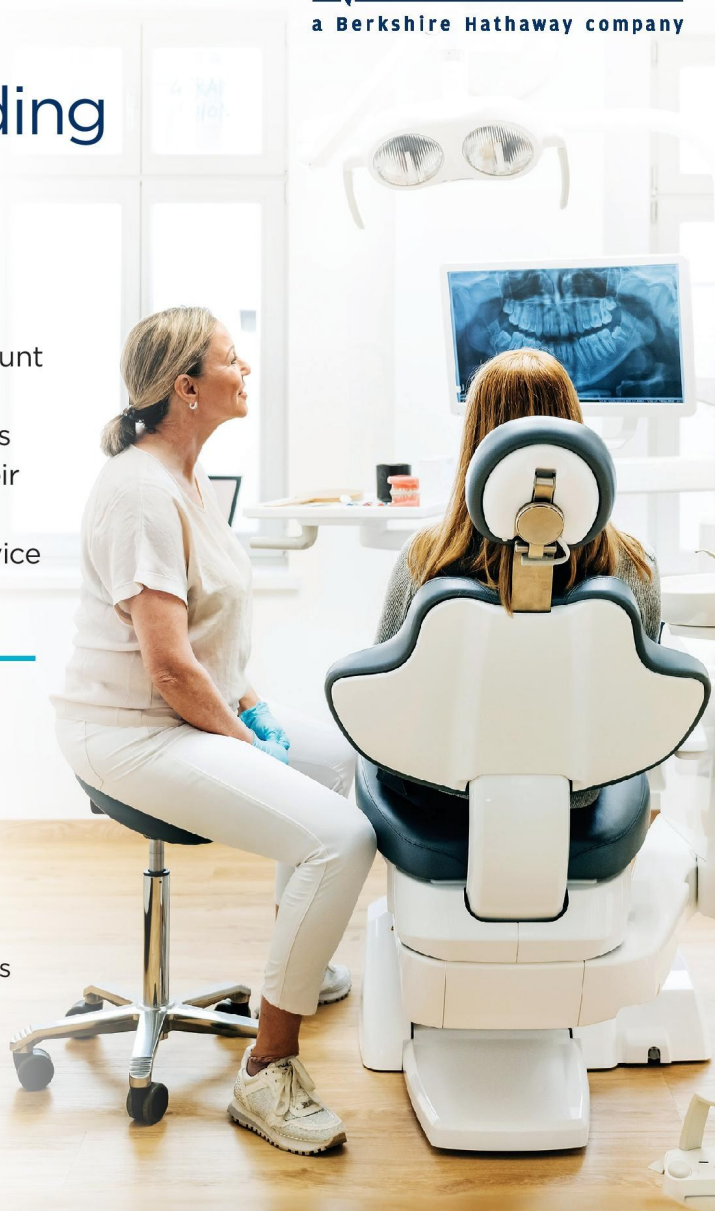

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Supporting the Next Generation of Dentists in a Changing Economy

Dentistry has always been a demanding profession, but today's economic environment is creating a new set of challenges—particularly for the younger generation of dentists entering practice.

New graduates are beginning their careers in a very different world than many of us experienced. They often face significant educational debt, increasing practice overhead, higher costs for supplies and technology, staffing shortages, rising salaries, insurance limitations, and growing pressure from patients who are themselves struggling financially. At the same time, young dentists are expected to invest in continuing education, incorporate new technologies, maintain high standards of care, and somehow build a financially sustainable career.

Clinical education prepares our graduates to diagnose disease and provide excellent treatment. However, knowing how to practice dentistry and knowing how to successfully manage a dental career are not always the same thing.

Young dentists need practical guidance. They need to understand how to evaluate employment contracts, manage educational debt, communicate with insurance companies, control overhead, build productive schedules, lead a dental team, understand basic practice finances, and decide when—or whether—to purchase or open a practice. They also need guidance on incorporating new technology without assuming unnecessary financial risk.

This is where organized dentistry becomes especially important.

Our Dental Society should be more than an organization that provides continuing education credits and professional meetings. It should be a professional home where young dentists know that experienced colleagues are ready to support them.

Those of us who have practiced for many years have something extremely valuable to offer: experience. We have made good decisions and, undoubtedly, some mistakes. Sharing both can help the next generation avoid unnecessary difficulties.

Mentorship should therefore become an increasingly important part of our mission. Educational programs addressing practice management, insurance, debt management, leadership, associate agreements, practice ownership, technology investment, and career planning can provide young dentists with tools that may be just as important to their long-term success as clinical continuing education.

We must also create more opportunities for different generations of dentists to communicate with one another. A young dentist should feel comfortable asking an experienced colleague, “How did you handle this?” And an experienced dentist should be willing to listen to the challenges of younger colleagues without assuming that the professional environment they are entering is the same one we entered decades ago.

The profession is changing. The economy is changing. Technology is changing. Patient expectations are changing. But one thing should remain constant: dentists supporting dentists.

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Need your help, what are your thoughts?

We want to accelerate membership growth. What ideas do you have? Send them along. Do these ideas make sense to you? There are challenges in virtually all associations and societies these days, it's not isolated to dentistry, but what do you think?. I'll start... I believe you get the outcomes

that you incentivize. Should we incentivize ADA, NYSDA and local component staff to grow Membership? Effectively tie their raises and/or bonuses to membership growth? Top volunteer leaders of these organizations may get a stipend (as they should for their time and personal sacrifices they make) but how about enhancing that stipend with Membership performance targets?

Do you think improved alignment could help? In other words, National, State and Local components could have shared target goals for membership. All the organizations benefit from membership growth, so why not be specific and incentivize with membership targets.

Local components are the front door or local face of the ADA and State associations. If a local component grows membership by 2% (for argument's sake let's assume that is also 2% dues revenue growth), that also benefits state and national associations. Could those associations afford to reward the outperforming local components? This would provide incentive to take money from reserves and invest in membership growth. Do you think a matching policy could help? For example, if Suffolk County Dental Society took \$15,000 out of reserves for a public facing Ad Campaign promoting the importance of seeing an ADA member dentist (reminding the public that not all dentists are members and the differences between a member and non-member dentist). They can find a member dentist on FindADentist.ADA.Org. Perhaps NYSDA could match that funding for its own similar themed Ad Campaign, and if the ADA additionally matched that of the States and Locals for a



similar themed national ad campaign, the effects would have a compounded impact... 55 state/territorial groups, and 545 local components all running similar themed ads. The public and all dentists would not be able to escape the message. All the organizations would be benefiting by membership growth, financial growth, and legislative impact. Members would realize we are driving patients to their chairs, we are raising the profile of ADA Members in the eyes of the public. Everyone wants to be held in high regard, regardless of practice modality (Military, Faculty, DSO, Private Practice, Etc.). DSOs would want their associated dentists to be members for fear of losing patients.

We know for sure this can work, we grew membership 2.5% a year while National and State membership had declined. I am thinking this can't be a one and done; you need to continue to grow membership and retain those members for life.

There is more to do. It is absolutely critical to retain younger/newer dentists. Their dues ramp up needs to be more affordable in those early years and a 12 monthly dues payment option is critical. I believe these two changes are in the works and that is great!

NYSDA ADVOCACY IN ACTION

NYSDA Continues Advocacy on CBCT Requirements

NYSDA is actively advocating on behalf of dentists affected by New York's new CBCT requirements.



WHAT CHANGED?

On July 22, 2026, the New York State Department of Health finalized regulations establishing new requirements for dental offices outside of New York City that use cone beam computed tomography (CBCT).

These regulations include an accreditation requirement.



NYSDA IS FIGHTING FOR MEMBERS

NYSDA formally opposed the CBCT accreditation requirement throughout the regulatory process.

Even after the regulations were finalized, NYSDA continued discussions with the Department of Health, medical physics organizations, and accreditation agencies to advocate for a compliance process that is as workable as possible for dental practices.



NEW YORK CITY DENTISTS: IMPORTANT CLARIFICATION

DOH recently clarified that the state's CBCT accreditation requirements **do NOT apply to dental CBCTs in New York City** (Bronx, Kings, New York, Queens, and Richmond counties).

New York City dental offices are governed by Article 175 of the New York City Health Code.

The role of the dental professional in the detection and management of pediatric sleep-disordered breathing

Pediatric sleep-disordered breathing (SDB), a general term for breathing difficulties during sleep ranging from loud snoring to obstructive sleep apnea, is a significant and often undiagnosed problem impacting the lives of numerous children. Sadly, for many of the children suffering from SDB, their condition often goes undiagnosed, leading to significant and unnecessary oral and systemic health implications that will impact them for the duration of their lives. Therefore, it is essential that the dental practitioner recognize the signs and symptoms of pediatric SDB, understand how to make the appropriate referral(s) to their dental and/or medical colleagues, and be cognizant of the role that interceptive orthodontic treatment can play in the improvement of SDB.

Dr. DeLuke will review the literature regarding the etiology, prevalence, and health implications of SDB in the pediatric population, describe the oral and systemic signs and symptoms most commonly present in patients who suffer from SDB, and demonstrate a unique and innovative approach to the interceptive orthodontic treatment of these patients. Numerous patient cases will be presented to exemplify how the dentist, orthodontist, and ENT/allergist can work together to transform the lives of children suffering from SDB. Whether you treat pediatric patients, screen and refer pediatric patients to your colleagues, or know any children (including your own!) who suffer from SDB, you do not want to miss this presentation!

Learning Objectives

- Review the etiology and prevalence of SDB in pediatric patients.
- Discuss the clinical signs and symptoms (both oral and systemic) of SDB in pediatric patients.
- Demonstrate how to radiographically evaluate the airway of pediatric patients using low-dose CBCT imaging.
- Review when and how to refer a pediatric patient with an airway issue to the ENT and/or allergist.
- Review the traditional options for orthodontic treatment to expand the arches of a pediatric patient.
- Explain an innovative technique to painlessly expand the arches, improve airway patency, and eliminate the need for extraction of permanent teeth using interceptive orthodontic treatment in preadolescent patients who suffer from SDB.

Michael K. DeLuke, DDS, MDS

Dr. Michael K. DeLuke obtained his DDS from SUNY Stony Brook, where he graduated as class valedictorian and was inducted into Omicron Kappa Upsilon. He obtained his Certificate of Proficiency in Orthodontics and Master of Dental Science (MDS) degree from the University of Connecticut, serving as Chief Resident in his final year. Dr. DeLuke is a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics, served as the orthodontist on the prestigious Cleft Craniofacial Team at Albany Medical Center, served as a clinical professor at Ellis Hospital, the University of Connecticut Health Center Department of Orthodontics, and the NSU College of Dental Medicine in the Department of Orthodontics. He is currently a visiting adjunct faculty member in the Montefiore Einstein Orthodontic Residency Program. Dr. DeLuke owned and operated DeLuke Orthodontics in Upstate NY from 2005 – 2023, and launched DeLuke Orthodontic Coaching in 2022 with the mission of helping his colleagues succeed both personally and professionally. He has lectured at numerous regional and national meetings over the past 20 years, has published multiple articles in orthodontic journals, and sits on the editorial board of OrthoTown Magazine. Dr. DeLuke is also the creator and host of The DOC Podcast.
